## The Circular Instrument Project is Underway!

ReachAnother has delivered thousands of medical instruments to seven hospitals across Ethiopia. Now, many surgeons will have access to urgently needed specialized tools.





ReachAnother's Center of Excellence in Pediatric Neurosurgery at St. Peter's Hospital in Addis Ababa received 31 different surgical instruments which can be used for pediatrics neurosurgery, obstetrics and gynecology, orthopedics, and for the use of general surgical medical services.

Thanks to Dutch hospitals that make redundant instruments available to colleagues in Ethiopia, a new shipment of instruments in now en route to our partners hospitals.
